NODC is currently working with area governments, tribes, and other partners to build on the 2015 Climate Change Preparedness Plan to 1) set key climate change priorities and strategies for governments on the North Olympic Peninsula and 2) build capacity for government jurisdictions to coordinate and implement climate change adaptation and mitigation strategies for regional climate resilience.

The third meeting on May 25<sup>th</sup> will aim to refine and confirm a variety of potential climate change strategies related to regional water systems, energy, transportation, food security and sovereignty, wildfires and wildfire smoke, and land use.

Who should attend: Elected officials and key staff members of tribal governments, counties, cities, ports, PUDs, state and federal agencies and other organizations concerned with climate change strategies for the North Olympic Peninsula.
