2022 Priorities



\$1.5 million in Capital Budget funding for the Point Hudson Jetty replacement project.



Support Aviation Fuel Tank Removal Funding.



Increase funding for derelict vessel remediation.



Support full ferry service and expand ferry investments.



• Extending **0.09% sales tax (PIF)** for rural counties to fund public facilities for economic development purposes.



• Support investments in broadband infrastructure.



 Support funding for the Model Toxics Control Act and reduce regulatory barriers to accessing MTCA funds.

2022 Interim – What's ahead?

- The entire House of Representatives and half of the Senate are up for re-election.
- Over 20 legislators are either not seeking re-election, retiring, were re-districted out following the 2020 census, or are seeking other office.
- The upcoming 105-day session will bring many new faces to Olympia.
