The Port of Port Townsend Commission met for a regular business session at the Point Hudson Pavilion Building, 355 Hudson Street, Port Townsend, and also online via Zoom.

- I. CALL TO ORDER & PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE (Rec. 1 00:00:00) Commissioner Hasse called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.
- II. APPROVAL OF AGENDA (Rec. 1 00:01:30)Agenda was approved as written by unanimous consent.
- III. PUBLIC COMMENTS (Rec. 1 00:01:35)

<u>David Goldman</u> read written comment into the record regarding concerns and misunderstandings about the Lower Sims Gateway and Tree Management Project.

Commissioner Hanke moved to accept the Consent Agenda as written; motion passed unanimously.

- VII. REGULAR BUSINESS (Rec. 2, 00:07:30)
  - A. COMMISSION AUTHORIZATION TO AWARD BID AND EXECUTE CONTRACT FOR POINT HUDSON MARINA JETTY RESTORATION (Rec. 2, 00:01:07)

Director of Capital Projects and Port Engineer Klontz reported that in late June several marine construction firms submitted bids for the Point Hudson Breakwater Replacement project. Orion Marine Construction came in with the winning bid at \$10,256,106, less than the engineer's estimate which was \$14 million. On Tuesday of this week, the Port received Economic Development Administration (EDA) authorization to award the project. The work is scheduled to begin September 15 just after the completion of the Wooden Boat Festival. The order for the piling was placed by the contractor last week and should arrive in mid-October according to schedule. Port staff has asked for an increase of the wall thickness which will increase the project cost and extend the life of the jetty.

<u>Commissioner</u> comments were in favor of the bid award as well as having some financial flexibility for any needed change orders on the project. Commissioner Hasse moved to approve the award bid to execute a contract for the Point Hudson Marina Jetty Restoration; approved by unanimous consent.

VIII. STAFF COMMENTS (Rec. 2, 00:12:00)

Executive Director Berg reported that a wherry storage area has been added at Boathaven using four parking spaces that were relatively unused. Toward the goal of local/easy access

to the water, there will still be an effort to create an additional "mast up" sailboat parking area. He and Operations Manager Sparks toured the Coyle Peninsula on *Clean Bay* the electric pumpout vessel. In addition, the *R Munson* might be retrofitted and employed as an additional pump out vessel through a contract with the Northwest School of Wooden Boatbuilding. The granting agency has given permission for this arrangement. Inflation has reached 10.1% and staff is looking at how this might affect the budget and future Port rates.

<u>Draft Port Logo (15:00)</u>: Executive Director Berg presented the conceptual Port logo by Artist Marian Roh of the Schooner *Alcyone* coming home at sunset with four of its eight sails and lighthouse. He led a discussion and sought feedback on whether the Commission was ready to implement the new design on Port signs and business materials replacing the two designs in use currently. Commissioner Petranek wanted a Jefferson County backdrop including the Olympics which was difficult to represent. This is a return to the similar 1920s design with a lighthouse.

Commissioners: There was overall support of the artwork and discussion about its complex design. It is a good representation of a local boat and our Port even if not a gaff-rig fishing schooner with all sails up. It was noted that the sails as represented are accurate for the angle and winds in that location. There was an eagerness to see the more simplified renditions to be used as the logo. Staff responded that some signage would represent the full color artwork, however implementation would involve a spectrum of versions including a black and white logo as well as a line drawing possibly without the lighthouse. There was Commission and staff consensus around the public suggestion to ensure inclusion of the language "serving Jefferson County."

Licensing for Gray Whale Skeleton on Union Wharf (Gunther): (00:23:46) Berg gave a presentation on the cleaning and reconstruction of the whale carcass proposed for educational display by the Port Townsend Marine Science Center (PTMSC). With Commission support, the Port would license this use for mutual community benefit with no fee other than an initial cost of \$3,000-5,000 for the spot lighting and security cameras. It would occupy one third of the space under the covered area and be seven feet high at the lowest point with the ability to walk under the 10-foot-high fluke. A railing with interpretive signage would surround the structure. National Oceanic and Atmospheric Association (NOAA) owns and has permitted the structure.

<u>Commissioners</u> were supportive of the project given the increase in whale and seal activity in the area. Concerns related to the project were budget, weather exposure, and the planned structural design for the large exhibit, including long-term maintenance. Berg confirmed the Port would not have responsibility for the exhibit. Maintenance would fall to the PTMSC. The arrangement envisioned is a no-fee educational license, renewable annually. In the future, there could also be a partnership on a water intake system. No City permitting is needed for the placement, but City Historic Design Review would be needed for the railing.

Commissioner Hanke moved to authorize the Executive Director to enter into a license agreement with the Port Townsend Marine Science Center for the Gunther Exhibit at Union Wharf; unanimously approved. (00:33:00)

<u>Director of Capital Projects Klontz</u> reported that several weeks ago, the engineer who will assist with the Quilcene Marina dredging project design met to assess the facilities. Yesterday they met to discuss the underwater survey, so progress is underway on the preliminary design. An Open House would be held Saturday, August 6 at the Port Townsend Community Center to provide an update on the Sims Gateway Boatyard Expansion project. Stakeholder group input will be presented on the range of options from "no action" to "poplar removal." (00:34:37)

<u>Lease and Contracts Administrator Nelson</u> announced commitments of the two remaining water view offices at Point Hudson. Marine Resources Consultants is exercising their only two-year lease option for the Armory Building. US Coast

Guard is planning to negotiate a new lease and discussions continue with Sea Marine. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife is interested in making a proposal on renting the Cupola Annex. A meeting with Dave Ward was held to discuss amending the NW Hangars airport 2, 7, and 8 lease, and entering into a new lease for hangar construction at Site 2. A meeting with LGB Development is scheduled next week to discuss a new lease for Sites 1 and 3 and formally terminate the expired lease at Sites 1 and 3. (00:37:20)

<u>Commissioner Hanke</u> spoke about the good fortune and excellent functioning of the current Port team.

<u>Commissioner Hasse</u> concurred with the reorganization, team work, and realizing a vision of a harmonious work place. Diane Nelson (mother of Sue Nelson) was recognized for her generous donation of a piano to bring music into the Pavilion Building.

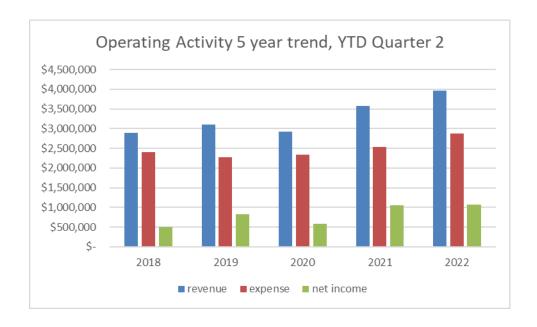

As requested by the Commission when reviewing the Quarter 1, 2022 operating results of Port activity, presented below is a graph summarizing the operating revenue and expense together with the net operating income/loss year by year in a five-year trend. This clearly depicts the year-to-year comparison of operating revenue and expense and the resulting net operating income/loss in the last five (5) years.



During the last five (5) years, the Port has been fairly steady with increasing operating revenue, expense, and net income. The operating revenue and expense amounts that increased year-to-year and those percentage changes are in the table below.

Whereas both operating revenue and expense have been increasing during this five-year period, the average rate of increase for revenue has been just under 50% than the average increase in expense. However, when looking at just this year, even though operating revenues appear strong when compared to 2021, a \$376,488 increase, the expenses appear to be almost keeping pace at an increase of \$350,488. Part of that expense increase is directly related to increased prices.

- (a) Overall, Operating Revenues increased by 11%, or \$401,947, when compared to 2021. When compared to budget, Operating Revenues are up by 14%, or \$481,204. In both instances, the bulk of this increase is related to the paydown of accounts receivable balances (43%, or \$171,357 of the 2021 variance, and 38%, or \$183,715 of the budget variance). The Yard continues to have the most significant increase in operating revenues, year over year as well as budget, with Point Hudson's operating revenues being the next highest.
- (b) Overall, Operating Expenses increased by 14%, or \$350,488, when compared to 2021. However, when measuring performance against budget, Operating Expenses YTD are more by only 4%, or \$123,559. Most line items are under budget, except for Facilities & Operations. In this area, the variance of expenses tracking higher than budget year to date include Repair & Maintenance (\$99,131), Operating Supplies (\$31,991), Bank Charges (\$19,994) and Equipment Rental (\$18,589).
- (c) Total Other Increases in Fund Resources increased by 30%, or \$620,550, when compared to 2021. This is largely due to IDD levy collections which are 98% of that increase. When comparing the current year to date to budget, we are below budget by 4%, or \$110,988.
- (d) Other Decreases in Fund Resources are less when compared to 2021 by 25%, or \$184,199. This is related to the final pay-off of the 2020 Line of Credit (LOC) in January 2021 in the amount of \$251,565. When compared to budget, this line item is 33%, or \$139,109, more than budget. The largest budget to actual increases were in Deposits Refunded (\$65,082), and in Miscellaneous Expense (\$39,651) which is related to the vessel destruction program with DNR, and Leasehold Excise Tax remitted (\$20,176). We can expect approximately \$86,000 from DNR for those expenses.
- (e) Overall, the difference in 2022 Net Income (Expense) when compared to 2021 is \$856,208, or 36%. This variance is primarily due to the pay-off of the 2020 Line of Credit in January 2021 for \$251,565, and the increase in other fund resources in 2022 of \$620,550, which is largely IDD. When comparing the Net Income (Expense) year to date to the budget, the variance is smaller at \$329,525, or 11%. Most of this increase over budget is represented by the strong Net Operating Income to-date.

### **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Per RCW 53.25, port districts are authorized to adopt an Industrial Development District (IDD) levy for the redevelopment of lands in an IDD designated area. The IDD Levy was adopted by the Commission via resolution 698-19 after a vote of the people approved it in the November 2019 election and includes all three districts of Jefferson County.

The purpose of this report is to keep the Commission apprised of the Industrial Development District (IDD) receipts and authorized capital expenditures activity during the term of the levy. It includes the annual budgeted tax receipts and capital project expenses as well as the actual year-to-date tax receipts and capital project expenses since the inception of the levy. In addition, we have included the running total of the estimated remaining levy amount that can be taxed, the annual millage rate, and the reserve fund balance as of the date of the reported quarter's reconciliation transfer.

Monthly IDD-funded capital expenses are paid from the Port's general fund, but the general fund is not reimbursed from the IDD reserve until the quarterly reconciliations are prepared and executed. When the quarter-end reconciliation is created and the transfer (reimbursement) is made to the general fund, those figures are entered into this report.

### FISCAL IMPACT

The report shows the income, expenditures, and current balance of the IDD Reserve fund. The largest project planned for this year is Point Hudson Jetty replacement, a 2-year phased project, that is approximately 2/3 of the year's capital budget that is partially funded by the IDD. This project is moving forward to commence construction in September.
