


The Point Hudson Preservation Plan

- \succ Endorsed by the Commission June 2020
- Incorporated in the Comp Scheme Oct 2020
- Essence of the Plan "Preserve this Special Place"
- \succ Priorities Established by the Plan
 - 1. Replace the Breakwater
 - 2. Restore the Historic Station Buildings
 - 3. Renovate Utilities & Infrastructure

"We are determined to save and renew Point Hudson so it continues its central role in both the life of the community and in the maritime world for generations to come."



HVAC/Fresh Air Upgrades (e.g. Cupola Building, \$113k in '24)

 Roof Rehabilitation (Approx. \$600k over 8 buildings)

Phase 3 – Infrastructure Upgrades/Site Improvements

> Trail and Harbor Revetment Repairs

> Landscaping/Interpretive Signage

> RV Park Upgrades

Potential Funding Sources

Aquatic Lands Enhancement
Account (ALEA) Funds (WDNR)

 Heritage Capital Projects (HCP), Washington State Historical Society





Heritage Capital Projects

- Preserve or protect "public access" to history
- > \$10k-\$1,000,000
- > 2:1 Local Match, 6 year reach-back
- 2 Stage Process
 - Stage 1 project eligibility
 - > March 29
 - Stage 2 Full Proposal
 - Due June 7
 - > Funds available July 2025





Aquatic Lands Enhancement

- Improvement of Aquatic Lands for Public Purpose
- \$9.1 M Available, this cycle (\$500k per project)

> Schedule

- May 1 Prelim Apps Due
- > May 29-30 Review/Feedback
- > July 18 Final Applications Due
- > Aug 27-28 Project Evaluations
- October 29-30 Funding board final ranking
- ➢ Funding available July 2025
