BACKGROUND

Operational Data compiled from 2017 to present

DISCUSSION

Boatyard:

Haulout counts remain strong but overall length of stay in the yards remains short. The quick turnarounds are resulting in a decrease in yard/shipyard storage and represented by an overall lower occupancy. If previous years' trends in flow stay true, we would expect August to remain low until the end of the month/beginning of September and then pick up again as the commercial fleets return and the recreational boating season closes. There are currently 34 vessels scheduled for that time and growing.

Boat Haven:

Permanent occupancy fell slightly to 91% but remains overall stable. Waitlist assignments will happen, for a second round this year, in the second half of September. This round will bring the long-term assignments up to around 97-99% as we head into the Fall/Winter season. Nightly moorage did see an increase with summer traffic but remains low overall. Part of this is an increase in the number of guest monthly assignments due to the length of stays exceeding 7-10 days. This length makes it more economical for guests to pay for a month rather than our current nightly rate.

Point Hudson:

Nightly RV and Nightly Moorage continued to climb but are still below the average pace of the years previous by about 400 RV nights and 390 nights in the marina. A portion of the lost marina nights can be attributed to the marina closure through January and February. A large variance from average came from those same months in the RV park although the cold temperatures in January were an influencing factor. Overall, the demand for nightly recreational activity this year has seemed to decrease at our facilities as we have seen lower than average counts for most months to date. No construction this Fall/Winter should lead to increased numbers on both sides.
