DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE & ADOPTION OF EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTS

Name of Proposal: Adoption of an Update to the Port of Port Townsend Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements ("CSHI" or "Comprehensive Scheme").

Description of Proposal: The Port of Port Townsend proposes modifications to its Comprehensive Scheme to reflect changing capital project priorities. The updated document proposes a range of capital rehabilitation, replacement, and improvement projects that are broadly consistent with the Port's 2013 Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements. The proposed improvements are also consistent with the "preferred alternative" identified within the integrated Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements adopted by the Port Commission in 2003.

Rather than property acquisition and expansion of capital infrastructure, the updated document emphasizes repair, rehabilitation and replacement of existing capital assets. No changes are presently proposed to the Port's portfolio of real property. Instead, the revised document updates the facilities description narrative of the CSHI and the specific improvement projects anticipated to be undertaken over the next 20 years (i.e., including updated project descriptions, estimated costs, and anticipated timing).

The updated CSHI will allow the Port to maintain eligibility for grants through the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO). The updated CSHI will also inform annual Port capital budgets and help to prioritize projects needed to maintain core Port infrastructure. The draft CSHI update will be introduced and discussed with the Port Commission at a Workshop session on Wednesday, September 9, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. in advance of the formal public hearing on Wednesday, September 23, 2020 at 1:00 p.m.

Location of Proposal: The Updated Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements would apply to all Port of Port Townsend facilities located within Jefferson County, Washington.
