

### **Groundbreaking Ceremony Point Hudson Jetty Replacement**


The Port of Port Townsend invites the community to attend the official groundbreaking for the long-awaited Point Hudson Jetty Replacement on Wednesday, September 14 at 3:30 p.m. at the northern breakwater near the anchors at Point Hudson. The project will rebuild both jetties for the historic Point Hudson Marina.

With funding from U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration, U.S. Fish and Wildlife/Recreation and Conservation Office, taxpayers of Washington State and taxpayers of Jefferson County through the 2019 Industrial Development District Levy, and Jefferson County Public Infrastructure Funds, the Port of Port Townsend contracted Orion Marine Contractors to rebuild the dilapidated jetties at the Point Hudson Marina. The rebuild work is scheduled to start at the conclusion of the Annual Wooden Boat Festival. It's a huge project on a tight project schedule that will require all Point Hudson vessels to depart during the four-month project window and would be repeated next year for the South jetty.

At the August 10 Commission meeting, Commissioners and staff celebrated the planned start of construction this fall while recognizing the disruptions for the community. Klontz asks all to be patient as we work in this area. We believe this tremendous improvement to our infrastructure and waterfront will be worth the temporary inconvenience.

## Park Rules For All Guests & Visitors

- Upon arrival, please check in immediately with Guest Registration for site, slip or dock space assignment.
- Fuels, oil, sewage and garbage must not be discharged onto the ground or into the waters of the Park.
- Children must be under adult supervision at all times and should wear life jackets while in the Marina.
- Please clean up after your pets. Pets must be leashed and under supervision at all times per city ordinance.
- Swimming is permitted from the beach but caution is advised as no lifeguard is on duty. Swimming is not permitted in the Marina.
- Climbing on the jetty or on the rocks in the Marina is not permitted.
- Fires are not permitted by city ordinance.
- Tent camping is not permitted by city ordinance.
- Trash is to be placed in the dumpsters and/or recycling containers.
- Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM.
- Check-out time is 12:00 Noon for the Marina and RV Park.
- Do not remove picnic tables from public areas.
- Guests remaining past their scheduled check-out time may be charged for an additional day unless prior arrangements are made with the Park.
- Guests who do not comply with these rules may be subject to eviction and forfeiture of fees.

## Additional Marina Rules

- Vessels must create no wake.
- Dinghies, personal watercrafts and other small crafts must not impede larger vessels.
- Vessels on west dock must permit other vessels to raft on.
- Vessels in slips must not overhang main dock.
- Barbecues must not be used on the docks.

## Additional RV Park Rules


